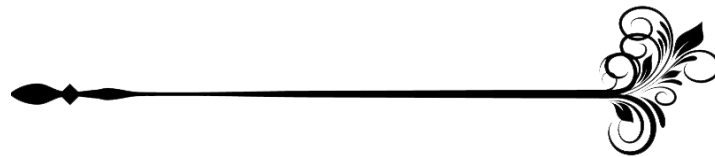
“The Metamorphic Worlds of Early Modern Literature”

Holder of a National Book Critics Circle Award, The Beatrice White Prize of the English Association, the Harry Levin Prize of the American Comparative Literature Association, and the Truman Capote Prize in Criticism, he has recently published *Tradition: A Feeling for the Literary Past* (Oxford, 2016) and *Shakespeare's Lyric Stage* (Chicago, 2018).
